

iPhone 4: How to transfer contacts

This document will help you to transfer your contacts from your current phone to the new iPhone 4. **The iPhone 4 uses a Micro – Sim** and so it's a bit tricky as most of the current phones use a normal Sim card which is bit bigger in size.



Scenario 1:

If you have an existing iPhone and are picking up a new iPhone 4

To transfer your contacts from your existing iPhone on to your new iPhone 4 you will first need to create a back up of your existing iPhone through iTunes. Once your existing iPhone is backed up you will need to connect your new iPhone 4 and restore it using the back up of your existing iPhone

Scenario 2:

If you have a Nokia/Sony/ Other handset and just got a new iPhone 4

If you already have your contacts stored neatly in Outlook (Windows), Address Book (Mac) or a Yahoo! Address Book (Mac/Windows), the process is as simple as syncing via iTunes.

You can then sync them to your iPhone: open iTunes, select your iPhone and choose the Info tab, then use check the "Sync Outlook contacts" or "Sync Yahoo Address Book" option.

If you're using a Mac, you have a few options. You can use [Address Book Importer](#) to push the .csv file data directly into Address Book then sync via iTunes. Or, you can import the .csv file into Yahoo! (login to your Yahoo! Mail account via a Web browser, select Options then Mail Options, then Contact Options, then Import/Export. Click the Browse button, and select your .csv, then click Import Now) and sync via iTunes.

Scenario 3:

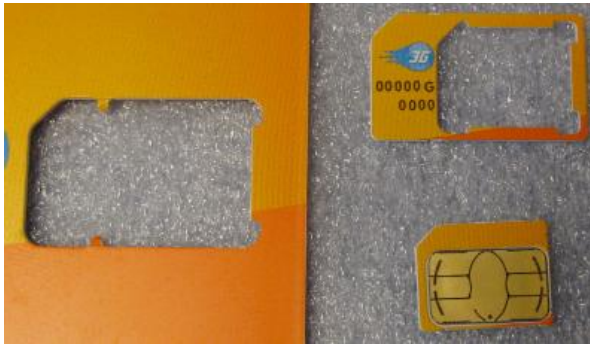
If you do not have access to a computer and your other phone is not an iphone

In this case if you receive a micro sim and if it's in a size of a normal sim card (PIC 1) where you will need to pull out the micro sim, **then please first insert that new sim card into your old phone** and copy contacts to the sim card.



(PIC 1)

Then you can remove the micro sim from that sim and now you have the contacts on the micro sim card (PIC 2)...Yipee



(PIC 2)

If you receive the Micro Sim directly then you will need to copy your contacts from your old phone to your new iPhone 4 manually.
